

Annual Auction Wrap-Up

As most of you already know, our annual wine tasting and auction fundraiser is our biggest event of the year. The funds raised (along with membership dues) provide needed funds for our doggie boxes, doggie bags, upkeep of bicycle racks, educational signs at the Point and Kings Lynn, the children's summer series in conjunction with the Fort Fisher Aquarium, seasonal seminars, scholarships for 2 local students each year, and when funds allow, larger items to support the community.

This year, our auction raised \$15,000 (before expenses) to support our initiatives! We are thrilled to have such amazing community members who donate goods, services, and handmade art, as well as attend our annual event! Our 2025 Grape Expectations fundraiser was attended by 122 ticketed individuals and 8 OKI BPSI board members. We received approximately 130 individual items for donation (although some were grouped into baskets).

Last year, our board voted to donate funds for 3 shower towers to the Town of Oak Island. Funds would be donated for one tower per year for the next 3 years. Last year's shower tower was placed at West 30th Street, and the Town has notified us that this year's shower tower location will be at the Keziah Street access. The Town chooses the location based on need and available utility placement, which the town provides and pays for. (Thank you, Town of Oak Island!) We do not have a date for installation, but we can tell you that this parking area provides handicap access for our residents and visitors. It is your support that allows us to give back to our beloved island, for the benefit of all of our families, and for that, we *THANK YOU!!*
